Our Measures to Prevent COVID-19 Spread

The health and safety of our visitors and staff are our highest priority. To help prevent the spread of Covid-19, we take measures and ask visitors to follow these guidelines. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

【Request to visitors】

Please observe the following:

1. Do not visit the museum if you feel unwell or have symptoms such as fever, cough or fatigue.
2. Take your temperature at the entrance and do not enter the museum if your temperature is 37.5°C or higher.
3. Wear a face mask. (Non-woven face mask is recommended.)
4. Wash or sanitize hands.
5. Maintain social distancing and refrain from speaking in a loud voice during your visit to the museum.
6. Drinking is only allowed in the designated area in the entrance hall.
7. Eating is not allowed in the museum.

【The museum's measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19】

1. Museum staff wear non-woven face masks.
2. The staff at the reception counter and museum shop serve guests from behind acrylic screen.
3. The staff will maintain social distancing during the tour.
4. High touch areas such as hand rails and elevator buttons are frequently cleaned and disinfected.

【Measures we will take if any Covid-19 case is detected at the museum】

1. In the event a museum staff member is found to be infected with Covid-19, we will notify the public health center and follow their instructions. We will post the information on the Museum website as appropriate.
2. Upon request from the public health center and relevant government organizations, we may provide them with the visitor tour booking information.
